- 203 representative districts, which shall be composed of compact

- absolutely necessary no county, city, incorporated town, 13

- Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General 16 17

- XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
- required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 21

- (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this 24
- proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the 25
- Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the 26
- advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 27
- Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 28
- advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 29

- newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
- this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 31
- Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 32
- to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 33
- primary, general or municipal election which meets the 34

- XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least 36
- three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is 37

passed by the General Assembly.

Section 3. Upon ratification by the electors, the General

Assembly shall enact legislation to implement this

constitutional amendment so that it applies for the first time

to the first session of the General Assembly which begins after

the 2020 reapportionment.
