

SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

SYNOPSIS:

Enacts the Public Employer Collective Bargaining Transparency Act.

SUMMARY:

Requires any proposed collective bargaining agreement be made available on the public employers' publicly accessible Internet website within 48 hours of receipt. Notice of the proposed agreement must be posted online both two weeks prior to and thirty days following the signing of the collective bargaining agreement. The posting shall include a statement of the terms of the proposed collective bargaining agreement, as well as estimate of the cost to the public employer associated with the agreement.

Additionally, the proposed collective bargaining agreements and any documents presented by the public employer or received from the employee organization in the course of collective bargaining are to be public records subject to the Right-to-Know Law.

Effective Date: 30 Days.
