

SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

Senate Bill 620 Printer's No. 617

Prime Sponsor: Senator Patricia Vance Committee: State Government

SYNOPSIS:

Allows certain lands within Cumberland County to be released with Project 70 restrictions.

SUMMARY:

Allows certain borough-owned lands within the Borough of Carlisle (Borough), Cumberland County, which contain a right-of-way along the Pennsylvania Turnpike, to be sold and therefore must be released from Project 70 restrictions. Proceeds from the sale of the right-of-way shall be deposited into a special interest-bearing account established by the Borough, for development of parks and open-space lands. None of the funds shall be disbursed until the Borough develops a plan and it has been approved by the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources. Any funds remaining in the account after 5 years shall be deposited into the Commonwealth's Project 70 Land Acquisition Sinking Fund or its equivalent.
