SYNOPSIS:

Allows therapy dogs on all forms of public transportation.

SUMMARY:

Amends the Human Relations Act to allow therapy dogs on public transportation. Currently, only service dogs are permitted on public transportation. A therapy dog provides emotional support to individuals in stressful situations. Therapy dogs are used by individuals with special needs, autism, drug addiction, clinical depression and bipolar disease.
