Prime Sponsor: Senator Alloway Committee: State Government

SYNOPSIS:

Changes the process an incumbent magisterial district judge follows to get on the primary ballot.

SUMMARY:

Amends the Pennsylvania Election Code within Section 912.1, "Number of Signers Required for Nomination Petition of Candidates at Primaries," to allow incumbent Magisterial District Judges to file a certificate of nomination for re-election, as opposed to collecting the 100 signatures, as is currently required.
