AN ACT

- Designating quartz as the official State mineral of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Official State mineral.
- 6 (a) Findings.--
- 7 (1) Quartz is one of the most abundant minerals in this
- 8 Commonwealth and can be found across Pennsylvania in many
- 9 forms and colors.
- 10 (2) Quartz can occur as beautiful, clear, six-sided
- 11 crystals called rock crystal. It can also occur as fine-
- 12 grained masses called chalcedony, which forms flint.
- 13 (3) Various colors of quartz exist and are known by
- descriptive names such as smoky quartz and rose quartz.
- 15 (4) The earliest inhabitants of this Commonwealth used
- 16 quartz to fashion arrowheads and cutting tools. The
- 17 availability of quartz, as well the hardness of this mineral,
- 18 made quartz a suitable raw material.

- 1 (5) Today, quartz is one of the most useful natural
- 2 materials and is utilized for a multitude of purposes, from
- 3 the manufacture of glass to the production of silicon
- 4 semiconductors for the computer industry.
- 5 (b) Designation.--Quartz is hereby designated as the
- 6 official State mineral of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 7 Section 2. Effective date.
- 8 This act shall take effect immediately.
