AN ACT

- Amending Title 25 (Elections) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in registration system, providing for audit of SURE
- 3 system.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 1208. Audit of SURE system.
- 9 (a) Audit. -- The Auditor General shall conduct an audit of
- 10 the Statewide Uniform Registry of Electors (SURE system) and
- 11 provide a report to the chairperson and the minority chairperson
- 12 of the State Government Committee of the Senate and the
- 13 <u>chairperson and the minority chairperson of the State Government</u>
- 14 Committee of the House of Representatives no later than June 30,
- 15 2018. The report shall include all of the following:
- 16 (1) Assessment of whether records maintained within the
- 17 <u>SURE system are accurate and in accordance with the Federal</u>
- 18 Help America Vote Act of 2002 (Public Law 107-252, 52 U.S.C.

- 1 § 21081 et seq.).
- 2 (2) Evaluation of the process for input and maintenance
- 3 of voter registration records.
- 4 (3) Determination of the security of the web-based
- 5 <u>Statewide voter registration system from unauthorized access.</u>
- 6 (4) Recommendations on how the department and
- 7 <u>commissions can increase the efficiency and accuracy of the</u>
- 8 <u>SURE_system.</u>
- 9 (5) Any other relevant information or recommendations,
- 10 as determined by the Auditor General.
- 11 (b) Cooperation. -- The department and all commissions shall
- 12 cooperate fully with the Auditor General and provide timely
- 13 responses to requests for information or comment.
- 14 (c) Costs. -- The department shall reimburse the Auditor
- 15 General for the costs of the audit.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
