Amend Bill, page 5, by inserting between lines 12 and 13

Section 2. Restrictions on property owned by the Commonwealth, acting by and through the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.

Authorization.--Under the requirements of section 20(b) 14 (a) of the act of June 22, 1964, (Sp. Sess., P.L.131, No.8), known 15 as the Project 70 Land Acquisition and Borrowing Act, the 16 General Assembly hereby authorizes the release of Project 70 17 restrictions on land owned by the Commonwealth, acting by and 18 through the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, 19 which is more particularly described in subsection (b), in 20 exchange for the imposition of Project 70 restrictions on land, 21 which is more particularly described in subsection (c). 22
