 Located at Penn State Harrisburg within the Institute of State and Regional Affairs



Phase 2 The Voting District Project

- Provided states the opportunity to submit their voting district boundaries (ex. wards, precincts, etc.), codes and names
- Voting Districts submitted will be included in the 2020 Census Redistricting
 Data tabulations (P.L. 94-171 Redistricting Data)

Phase 2 In Pennsylvania

- PaSDC chosen by LDPC to provide Geographic Information Systems (GIS) support
 - Initial Identification of Updates -- December 2017 through May 31, 2018
 - Verification of Updates -- December 2018 through
 May 31, 2019
 - Verification of Updates II -- December 2019 through March 31, 2020

Common Activities for Phase 2

- Collected current voting district boundaries from each county – requested shapefiles (geographic file)
- Compared county boundaries to Census boundaries
- Compared county attributes to State (DOS and LDPC) attributes
- Created shapefiles if needed
- Submitted final county files to Census

Phase 2: Task 1

Initial Identification of Updates -December 2017 through May 31, 2018

- Requested voting district boundary files from counties (shapefiles)
- PaSDC worked with the Department of State (DOS) and LDPC to verify boundary changes, codes and naming conventions
- Created shapefiles if needed
- PaSDC uploaded county boundary files to Census

Phase 2: Task 2

Verification of Updates -December 2018 through
May 31, 2019



Additional Activities in Task 2

- Verification materials were posted by the Census Bureau on January 2, 2019
- Comparison of county changes to the Verification file provided by Census
- Review of the Boundary and Annexation Survey (BAS) changes
- Review of legislative and congressional district boundaries



County Updates Accomplished in Task 2

- 4 counties submitted boundary changes through BAS
- 3 counties confirmed no changes since the initial submission
- 52 counties provided a new file for this phase
- PaSDC worked with the Department of State (DOS) and LDPC to verify boundary changes, codes and naming conventions
- All 67 updated county files were provided to Census during this verification phase

Interim between Task 2 and Task 3

- Provided shapefiles back to counties for verification or questions
- Contacted counties about anticipated changes and developed a timeline for processing during the shorter (3 month) final verification phase

Phase 2: Task 3

Verification of Updates II --December 2019 through
March 31, 2020



- The PaSDC received the Census Verification packet for this phase on January 7, 2020
- 16 counties submitted boundary changes through the BAS
- 38 counties provided a new file for this phase.
- 29 counties confirmed no changes since the previous submission
- The 38 updated county files were provided to Census and notified them of the 29 with no changes during this verification phase

Interim between Phase 2 and Phase 3

- Monitored delays in Census timelines
- Contacted counties about anticipated changes
 - Prioritize work
 - Determine the frequency of contact needed in preparation for the receipt of data.

Updated Census Release Timeline

U.S. Census Bureau will deliver the state population counts for apportionment to the President April 30, 2021

U.S. Census Bureau will deliver the redistricting data to the states and the public by September 30, 2021



Phase 3 - Delivery of the 2020 Census P.L. 94-171 Redistricting Data Files and Geographic Products





Preparing for Phase 3

- PaSDC is reviewing the Geographic Data products for Pennsylvania provided by the Census Bureau
- Contacting counties and DOS to identify/verify potential changes
