SYNOPSIS:

Senate Bill 82 amends the Pennsylvania Election Code to further provide for powers and duties of county boards of election.

SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 82 requires county boards of elections to post as soon as possible, the results of primaries and elections to an Internet site that is updated as election returns are received after the polls close.
